AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OXFORD, COUNTY OF WARREN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING THE CONVEYANCE OF REAL PROPERTY AND ALSO AN INTEREST IN REAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE TOWNSHIP TO THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey, Department of Transportation ("State"), is undertaking certain infrastructure improvements along parts of State Road 31 within the Township of Oxford ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, as part of the Project, it is necessary for the State to acquire, either as fee simple or as an easement, property owned by the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township previously authorized the execution of, and did in fact execute, certain Agreements of Sale, which delineated the property to be acquired as part of the Project; and

WHEREAS, said conveyances to the State will serve a public purpose by improving infrastructure for the motoring public and is authorized by N.J.S.A. 40A:12-5.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Oxford, County of Warren, State of New Jersey that the Township does hereby authorize the conveyance of easements to the State of New Jersey, Department of Education, as set forth in Exhibits 1 & 2, attached hereto.

ORDINANCE NO. 2025-09 TOWNSHIP OF OXFORD

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FUNDING FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL PURPOSES FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF OXFORD AND APPROPRIATING \$204,974 FOR SUCH PURPOSE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OXFORD, IN THE COUNTY OF WARREN AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

- <u>Section 1</u>. The Township of Oxford, in the County of Warren, New Jersey, authorizes various capital improvements to be undertaken, including road repairs for storm damaged roads, including but not limited to Maple Avenue, Bush Street, Sharrer's Place, and other roads in need of repair as deemed appropriate by the Township Engineer and the Department of Public Works Supervisor in the Township of Oxford, to be funded from the sources specified in Section 2 of the Ordinance.
- Section 2. The amount of \$204,974.01 is hereby appropriated for the purposes stated in Section 1 of the Ordinance and which amount was funded from the Capital Improvement Fund in the amount of \$204,974.01.
- <u>Section 3</u>. In connection with the purpose and the amount authorized in Sections 1 and 2 hereof, the Township determines the purpose described in Section 1 hereof is not a Current Expense and is an improvement which the Township of Oxford may lawfully make as a general improvement.
- Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistency.
- Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon due passage and publication according to law.

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OXFORD, COUNTY OF WARREN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY MODIFYING SITE PLAN REVIEW REQUIREMENTS.

WHEREAS, The Township of Oxford desires to amend sections of Chapter 265 of the Township Code.

WHEREAS, The Township of Oxford desires to amend sections of Chapter 340 of the Township Code to align definitions of agriculture and agricultural use within the Township Code with guidance issued by the New Jersey State Agricultural Development Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OXFORD, COUNTY OF WARREN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The aforementioned recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.

Section 2. The Code of the Township of Oxford is hereby amended as follows:

3. Chapter 265-4 repealed as replaced in entirety as follows

265-4.A Site Plan review required; exemption

Site plan review and approval shall be required as a condition for the issuance of a permit for any development, except that individual lot applications for detached one- or two-dwelling-unit buildings which are part of a minor subdivision shall be exempt from site plan approval. Further, agricultural developments that are limited to expansion or change of use or conversion of land of growing agricultural crops are also exempt along with installation, reconstruction, expansion of utilities or structures/accessory improvements to protect crops such as fencing or hoop houses.

4. **Chapter 340-4-.C** the following definitions are added:

a. AGRICULTURE or AGRICULTURAL USE

- In addition to the definitions commonly ascribed to such words, specifically includes those uses recognized by the New Jersey State Agricultural Development Committee.
- b. AGRICULTURE CROP a cultivated plant or plant product that is grown and harvested for uses such food, medical purposes, industrial, consumption, landscaping,

industrial use or personal use as supported by New Jersey State Agricultural Development Committee guidance.

Section 4. If any part of this Ordinance shall be deemed invalid, such parts shall be severed and the invalidity thereby shall not affect the remaining parts of this Ordinance.

Section 5. A copy of this Ordinance and the Redevelopment Plan shall be available for public inspection at the office of the Municipal Clerk during regular business hours.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with all applicable laws.
