TOWNSHIP OF OXFORD ORDINANCE NO. 2025-16

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING PURCHASE OF THE DPW TRUCK F-350 FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF OXFORD AND APPROPRIATING \$55,000.00 THEREFOR FROM THE "CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND" OF THE SEWER AND GENERAL CAPITAL OF SAID TOWNSHIP

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Oxford in Warren County, New Jersey as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Township of Oxford in Warren County (hereinafter referred to as "Municipality") is hereby authorized the following Capital Improvements for the Township of Oxford:

1. Purchase of the F-350 DPW truck

Section 2. The work and acquisitions, authorized by Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be undertaken as a general improvement, the entire cost of which shall be contributed and borne by the municipality as a general expense, and no part of said cost shall be specially assessed against any property. The estimated cost noted of such project shall not exceed \$55,000.00 unless this Ordinance is amended.

Section 3. It is hereby determined and stated that the undertaking of the aforesaid projects (hereinafter referred to as "purpose") is not a current expense of the municipality; and that the total estimated cost of said purpose is \$55,000.00, the estimated cost for the projects having been noted in Section 1 above.

Section 4. The sum of \$55,000.00 is hereby appropriated for said purpose from the "Capital Improvement Fund" of the municipality for said purpose as required by law and now available therefore under a budget or budgets of the municipality previously adopted. The \$27,500.00 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund, General Capital and the other \$27,500.00 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund, Sewer Utility Capital.

<u>Section 5</u>. The Capital budget of the municipality is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as provided by law.

SUPPORTING THE RENEWAL OF AN APPLICATION REQUEST FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATION OF A FACILITY FOR EXPANDED ALTERNATIVE TREATMENT CENTER CULTIVATOR OPERATIONS ON PREMISES OCCUPIED BY GSCC MANAGEMENT LLC LOCATED AT BLOCK 26, LOT 87 IN THE TOWNSHIP OF OXFORD

WHEREAS, on November 3, 2020, the Marijuana Legalization Amendment was approved by voters in New Jersey, which legalized the possession and use of cannabis for residents twenty-one years of age or older; and

WHEREAS, on February 22, 2021, Governor Phil Murphy signed into law the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory, Enforcement Assistance, and Marketplace Modernization Act ("CREAMM Act"), which established the personal-use cannabis program in the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Oxford supports the safe and appropriate siting of cannabis businesses where such facilities are permitted pursuant to Ordinance 2021-10, to the extent consistent with applicable state and local statutes, rules, regulations, and ordinances; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2021-10 permits the operation of medical and adult-use licensees within the Township of Oxford; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2021-10 does not limit the number of medical and adult-use licensees within the Township of Oxford; and

WHEREAS, certain property exists within the Township of Oxford that is suitable to be developed with facilities for the operation of a Expanded Alternative Treatment Center ("ATC") Cultivator facility, as well as any other related or ancillary use (to the extent permitted by state law); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Oxford previously endorsed GSCC Management, LLC's initial application for state expanded ATC licensure by the State of New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission ("CRC") to operate a facility for an expanded ATC Cultivator operations on premises located at Block 26, Lot 87 within the Township of Oxford; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Oxford hereby join the CREAMM Act's initiative, and support and endorse GSCC Management LLC's application for renewal for state expanded ATC licensure by the State of New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission ("CRC") to operate a facility for an expanded ATC Cultivator operations on premises located at Block 26, Lot 87 within the Township of Oxford; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Oxford, County of Warren, State of New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. The Township of Oxford finds that it is important to provide for and protect the health and welfare of the citizens of the Township of Oxford, County of Warren, State of New Jersey, consistent with the CREAMM Act, N.J.S.A. § 24:6I-31 et seq.
- 2. As such, the Township of Oxford hereby supports the initiative taken by GSCC Management LLC to expand its facility to cultivate adult-use cannabis pursuant to an expanded ATC Cultivator license (to the extent permitted by state law) within the Township of Oxford's boundaries, particularly at Block 26, Lot 87, subject to, and in accordance with, all applicable ordinances and a redevelopment agreement.
- 3. The Township of Oxford has authorized the operation of both medical cannabis cultivator and Class 1 Cannabis Cultivator licensees within the Township, and the Township of Oxford does not limit the number of licensed cannabis businesses that may operate within the Township—and therefore, the issuance of an expanded ATC license to GSCC Management LLC will not exceed any limit imposed by the Township of Oxford on the number of licensed cannabis businesses.
